

Saint Stephen's vision to re-build and create vibrant hub for the local community



The story so far...

Nearly ten years ago the people of Saint Stephen's Church created a vision to serve the local community....children and families, the lonely, teenagers...actually anyone in need!

We set out, in partnership with several housing associations, to develop the site to accommodate people with special needs and create the new church building. Several times we have been disappointed as the various schemes have fallen through.

We talked to local people who said things aren't like they used to be they said things like...

what is there here for the kids?... they're at a loose end, out on the streets with nothing to do, nowhere to go, and sometimes with stuff they need to talk about ...but who is listening? older people say they are lonely and isolated in their homes, the hours pass too slowly with nobody to talk to or to listen to them. Their stories and wisdom is wasted.

Workers go from home to car to office and back and may not even know their neighbours anymore. There's no

Our Vision

We wanted to create a place of celebration, a hub where local people can call their own, where birthdays, anniversaries, and weddings and baptisms, and funerals can take place.

Where local services, like the post office have been removed we wanted to provide this facility again. We wanted to work alongside the local health practitioners to add to local healthcare services.



We wanted to provide a safe place for teenagers and young adults to meet.

We wanted to improve the playground facilities.

That was years agoour vision hasn't changed!

How can we rebuild our sense of community?

Saint Stephen's has a vision to create a place for the community in the heart of your area. Run by residents for residents. A place for everyone.

Just imagine...

a place where:

- kids feel safe... with something to do, gym, a place to belong, youth & careers advisers, mentors, training & volunteering opportunities
- everyone knew each other...
 or had a relaxed area like the cafés and gardens, to get to know each other
- there is somewhere to go... not far, not home, not a neighbour's, but a neutral space
- can take pride and participate in a joint project, including gardening, litterpicking, volunteering to run the café or groups

- the elderly, lonely, or sick could find company and share a pastime in a friendly, supportive environment, at a low cost, and close to home
- there's always something on and someone to talk to
- someone listens; that is dementia friendly and a support to carers
- you can pick up your parcels, buy some stamps
- you can receive some health care without going too far
- where you can influence what's going on

- spaces are available for hire at reasonable rates,
- Scouts and other organisations can meet
- family celebrations like weddings, baptisms and funerals can take place in a purpose designed environment
- it is quiet, where you can think and pray in those moments where you just need somewhere to go where help is at hand



How do we get there from where we are now?

Our partnership with housing associations hasn't worked out. We believe in partnering with the local people and with businesses and other agencies. We are excited to work in partnership with Southend Council but all have their part to play.

The sale of part of the site will provide about one third of the sums needed. We are applying for grants, but this won't take us all the way. We have to raise the money locally....it is a community project with local people, for local people.

The Lifestreams project creates a chance for the community to invest in your future. If 1000 people can raise £1000 in 2 years we'll make it!!

That's less than £10 per week! What can I do?
